## AIR POLICY & REGULATORY MANAGER

### **BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:**

Must have experience with the US and/or California environmental regulatory agencies, law, and regulation in the areas of air quality and global warming.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

Bachelor Degree in Environmental Policy, Engineering, Business or related field or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience:

- Typically possesses seven or more years experience in organizational programs, policy analysis and relations with environmental regulatory agencies, including five or more years of supervisory or project management experience.
- Demonstrated experience in the rulemaking process governed by the state and federal Administrative Procedures Acts.
- Demonstrated experience to accurately analyze information, integrate people processes, systems, and technologies, and make strategic decisions regarding project scope, impact, policy, development, and implementation.
- Demonstrated experience with environmental project or program oversight.
- Demonstrated experience with legislative review.
- Demonstrated knowledge of environmental regulatory aspects of large electrical generation, transmission and distribution systems, including power generation and transmission/distribution systems such as Southern California Edison.
- Must have excellent personal interaction, oral and written communication skills, and be customer focused to appropriately identify and respond to internal clients' business needs and facilitate the presentation of recommendations.
- Must demonstrate the ability to interface effectively and collaborate with clients, peers, project personnel and all levels of management to develop solutions and ensure stakeholder buy-in.
- Must demonstrate the ability to take initiative and accountability for results.
- Must be proficient in use of typical computing software tools.

### **PREFERENCES:**

Master's degree in Environmental Policy, Engineering, Business or related field.

**TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The successful candidate will act as a liaison with assigned environmental regulatory agencies and expert trade associations.

- working with Corporate Environmental Health and Safety, Law, and Operating divisions to refine positions on pending environmental issues and cases
- keeping the Corporate Environmental Policy Division informed of pending legislation and regulation
- working with trade associations and other coalitions including environmental nongovernmental groups for resolution of policy issues of concern to Edison
- leading and/or participating in Corporate Teams (such as representatives from Public Affairs, Law, Power Production, and Operations Support) dealing with issues of significance such as resolution of lack of emission offsets for the citing of power generation within Edison's load center, implementing the California Climate Solution Act of 2006 and performing other duties and responsibilities as required.
