



There are two requirements for Evaluation as a Research Tool:

1. **The requirement in the logic and vocabulary of evaluation.** A grade of B or better in *Psych 315b: Foundations of Evaluation* (2 units), and 2 or more additional units of evaluation coursework, which may include the summer Professional Development Workshops if taken for credit (*Psych 352l*). *Foundations of Evaluation* is typically taught during the Fall semester.
2. **The requirement in the application of evaluation.** A substantial example of doctoral level work consisting of the evaluation of a real program, or the further development of evaluation theory or methodology to the level of a publishable article. In either case, the proposed topic must be cleared by the Dean or his/her appointee for the purpose; the proposal should provide substantial detail that would normally require several pages of explication.
