Jenness Hannigan was a neighbor of Mark Lipsey (a former CGU Psychology professor) when Mark lived in Palmer Canyon north of Claremont. In gratitude for Mark's generous assistance to her, she willed her modest estate to Mark's favorite charity. Fortunately for us, this "charity" was the Psychology program at CGU. Earnings from investment of the estate can be used to support graduate student research.

Research Fellowship of \$200 will be awarded to Psychology graduate students who have incurred expenses of at least \$200 in pursuit of their research agenda. Preparation of research materials, payment for research participants, or travel to a professional conference to present a paper or poster are examples of expenses that qualify for consideration of the Fellowship. The Fellowship award will be reported on the IRS 1099 Form. Fellowship recipients may be able to document deductible expenses for tax purposes. You may apply for funds prior to incurring expenses, but cannot apply for reimbursement until after expenses have been incurred.
