**Auditor's Fees**

Auditing of courses with the permission of the instructor is available to qualified persons at a fee of \$610 per 4-unit course or \$305 per 2-unit course. Students enrolled in at least 12 units in the same semester may take up to 4 audit units at no extra charge. However, art students must be enrolled in at least 15 units in the same semester to take up to 4 audit units at no extra charge. There are no EMP courses offered for audit.
