In recognition of the diverse faiths represented at the university and our community, Claremont Graduate University's tradition is to invite one member of The Claremont College's Chaplains to deliver the Invocation. This invitation is extended on a rotating basis to all of the four Chaplains as part of our commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion.

Please assist us in making today's ceremony enjoyable by keeping the aisles clear at all times.

## COMMENCEMENT MISSION STATEMENT AND PURPOSE

Commencement at Claremont Graduate University represents the culmination of a student's academic achievement. It is a time for celebration and reflection for students, families, faculty, and staff. It brings together a diverse community to share in the joy of the accomplished goals of students.

The commencement ceremony at Claremont Graduate University serves a dual purpose: to mark a significant accomplishment, thus completing a chapter in the lives of students and those who support them; and to encourage the continued pursuit of education and personal fulfillment.



## THE UNIVERSITY MACE AND PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The civic, or ceremonial, mace is thought to date from about the 13th century, and the Claremont Graduate University mace was designed and constructed in 1984 by John S. Temple, an MFA student, who used native California hardwoods exclusively in its

construction. The sculptural interpretation of the flame is handcarved from mesquite wood and depicts the flame of learning in the Claremont Graduate University logo. The remaining elements in the mace are of lathe-turned claro walnut and black walnut. Six claro walnut rods, symbolizing each of the then-six Claremont Colleges, are symmetrically arranged to form the main body of the mace and are joined together at the ends with turned forms of black walnut. The entire mace is assembled with dowels; no metal fasteners are used. A special formula of beeswax and oil has been used to finish the mace and protect it for years to come.

The university mace is carried in procession on occasions of outstanding importance, such as commencements, convocations, and formal dedications. The placement of the mace on its stand signals that the proceedings are about to come to order; its retirement indicates the conclusion of the exercises. The mace is carried in procession by the chief marshal.

The presidential medallion is worn by the president at formal academic occasions. The medallion identifies its wearer as the temporary embodiment of the institution's power and authority. Claremont Graduate University's presidential medallion is a bronze casting of the university's seal. This symbol, designed according to the science of heraldry, consists of a shield containing three lamps and one flame, surrounded by the name of our institution and its founding date, 1925. The gift of the medallion with the linked bronze chain of office was commissioned in 1998 by the presidential candidate search committee.

## ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic costumes worn in the procession at today's ceremony trace their origins to those worn by faculty and students at medieval European universities. With minor modifications, these costumes have remained largely unchanged since the 16th century. Regalia standards for colleges and universities in the United States were established in 1895 with the adoption of an intercollegiate code that specifies design and color appropriate for various degrees.

The modern academic costume consists of three parts: the gown or robe, a headpiece, and a hood. The gown denotes the wearer's level of education. The doctoral gown is full flowing and has large bell-shaped sleeves. It is trimmed with velvet panels down the front and has velvet chevrons on the sleeves. The master's gown has a closed or glove sleeve that is open at the wrist. Both the master's gown and the doctoral gown may be worn either open or closed. The baccalaureate gown is the simplest in design. Usually black, it is distinguished by a wide yoke with shirring in the front and back and by open flowing sleeves that end in a point. The gown is worn closed.

The mortar board, or Oxford cap, is the headpiece usually worn at American universities. The mortar board is appropriately worn with the board flat on the top of the head.

Of the costume's three components, the hood is the most interesting. Originally it had three uses: as a head covering, as a shoulder cape, and as a bag in which alms could be collected. It is mentioned as early as 1480 in classical literature. When large wigs were in vogue in Britain, the cape part of the hood was split in front and a narrow neckband inserted. The color of the velvet trim on the hood designates the subject field of the degree; the width of the trim designates the level of the degree; and the lining, the colors of the university granting the degree.

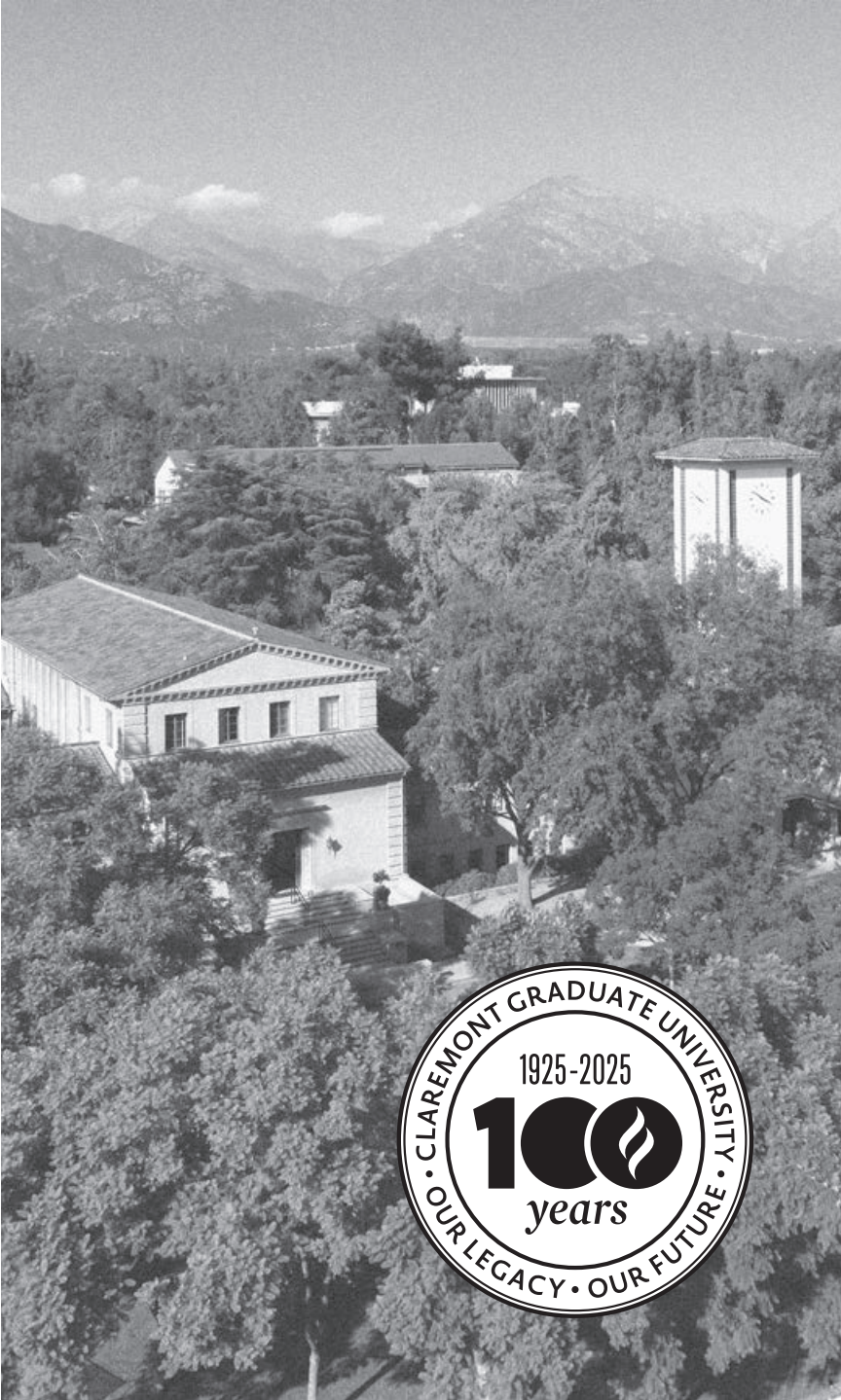

## COMMENCEMENT KEYNOTE SPEAKER AND HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

*Doctor of Science, honoris causa*

Kate Darling, PhD



Dr. Kate Darling is a leading expert on the evolving role of robotics in everyday life. She serves as a research scientist at MIT's Media Lab and leads the Ethics & Society team at the Boston Dynamics AI Institute. Her groundbreaking work in social robotics and human-robot interaction examines the emotional connections people form with lifelike machines — research that is shaping both technology design and public policy.

“I’ve always been really interested in how people treat automated technologies like they’re alive, despite knowing that they’re just machines,” Darling says. Through her studies, Darling tackles the critical questions engineers, lawmakers, and society must address as our relationships with intelligent machines continue to develop.

With a background in law, economics, and intellectual property, she has explored the economic incentives behind copyright and patent systems. She has served as an intellectual property policy advisor to the MIT Media Lab and helped establish the MIT-BU Technology Law Clinic. A former fellow at both the Harvard Berkman Klein Center for Internet & Society and the Yale Information Society Project, she currently serves as senior co-chair of *We Robot*, the leading conference on robotics law and policy.

A prominent voice in her field, Darling has been featured in the *New Yorker*, *BBC*, *WIRED*, the *Atlantic*, and more. She writes a monthly column for *BBC Science Focus* and has contributed to *Robohub* and *IEEE Spectrum*.

She holds a doctorate from ETH Zurich and an honorary doctorate from Middlebury College, and she is a recipient of the American Bar Association's Mark T. Banner Award for Intellectual Property. She is also the devoted caretaker of several domestic robots, including her Pleos: Yochai, Peter, and Mr. Spaghetti.

## STUDENT SPEAKER

### Kendall Hutchison Acker, MA in History, 2025



Kendall Acker is a cross-border Canadian scholar whose work explores the intersections of historical narratives, Indigenous representation, and American tourism. She is currently completing her master's degree in American history and museum studies at Claremont Graduate University.

Her thesis, *The Price Tag of a 5-Star Culture: Cultural Performance and the Politics of Luxury in O'ahu Hotels*, examines how luxury hotels in Hawai'i curate Native Hawaiian experiences in ways that perpetuate settler-colonial ideologies and obscure the lived realities of Hawaiian people under American statehood. Kendall's research is shaped by the mentorship of Dr. Joanna Poblete and Dr. Joshua Goode, whose guidance has deepened her commitment to equity, fairness, and justice in historical scholarship.

Acker earned her bachelor's degree in history and Indigenous studies from the University of British Columbia. With over a decade of experience in museums and public history, Kendall is passionate about the role of cultural institutions in advancing underrepresented narratives. Her work is grounded in decolonizing practices and a commitment to transforming institutional traditions to authentically integrate Indigenous voices.

Looking ahead, Kendall plans to pursue a PhD in American history at the University of Alberta, where she will continue to explore the transformative potential of museums, archives, and other cultural spaces.

Outside of academia, Kendall lives in Kelowna, Canada, with her husband, Owen, and their two Bernese Mountain dogs, Tesla and Maple. Deeply invested in her community, she finds fulfillment in facilitating meaningful connections with the people around her. Whether personal or professional, Kendall believes that transformative change begins with respectful, holistic relationships to the stories and lands that shape who we are and where we belong.

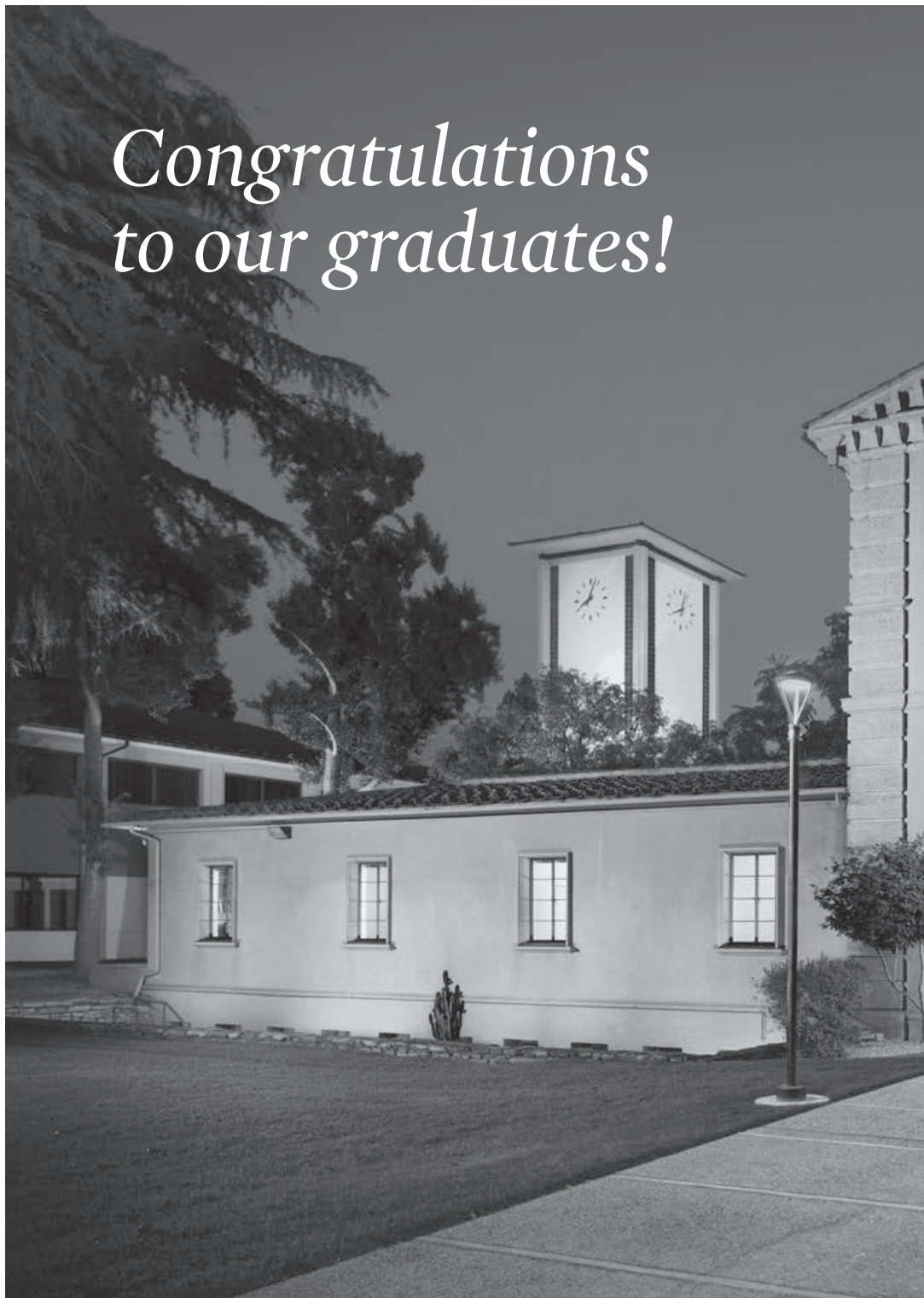
Driven by a passion for inclusive, experiential education, Joleen integrates nature-based methodologies and trauma-informed practices into her work,

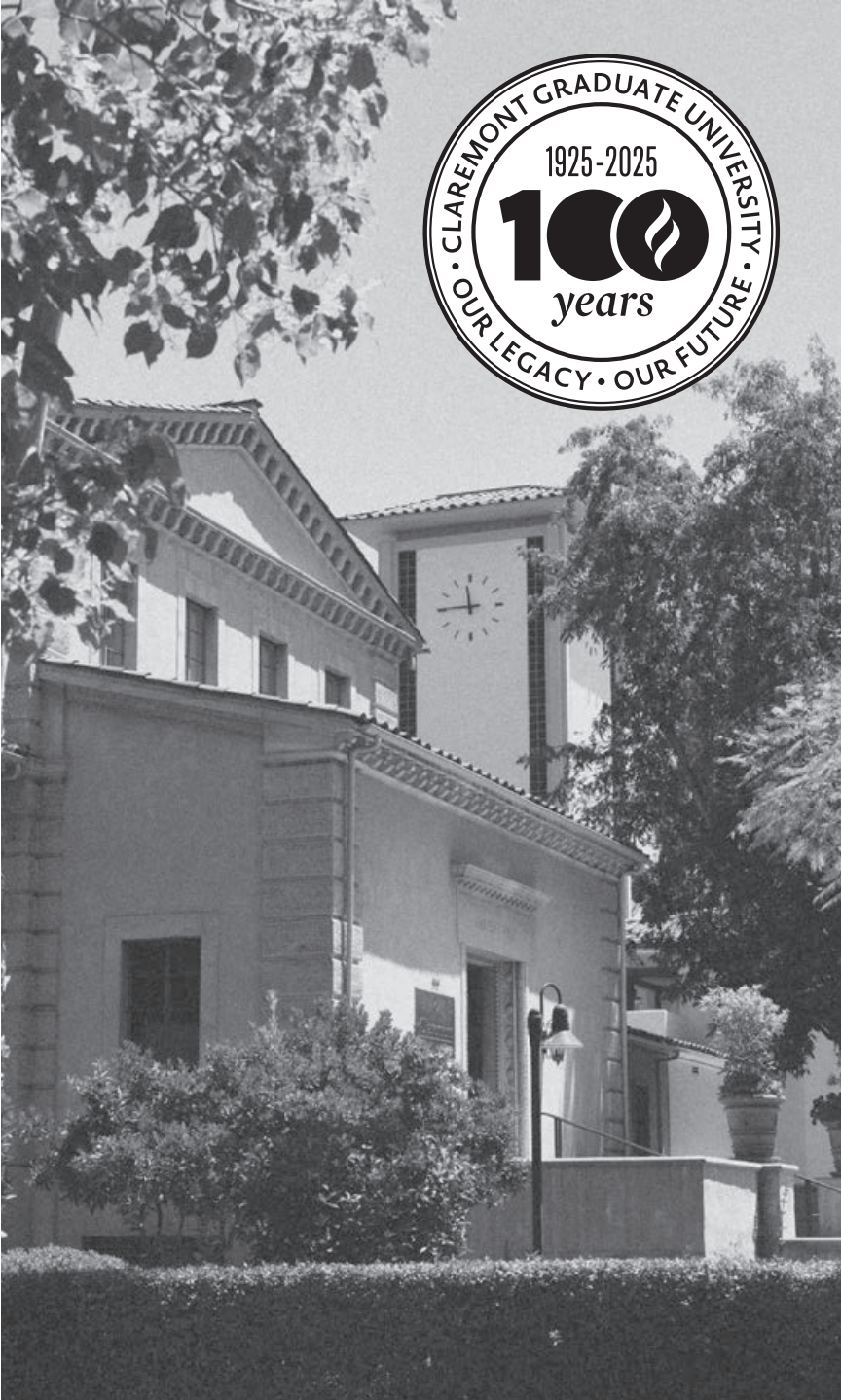

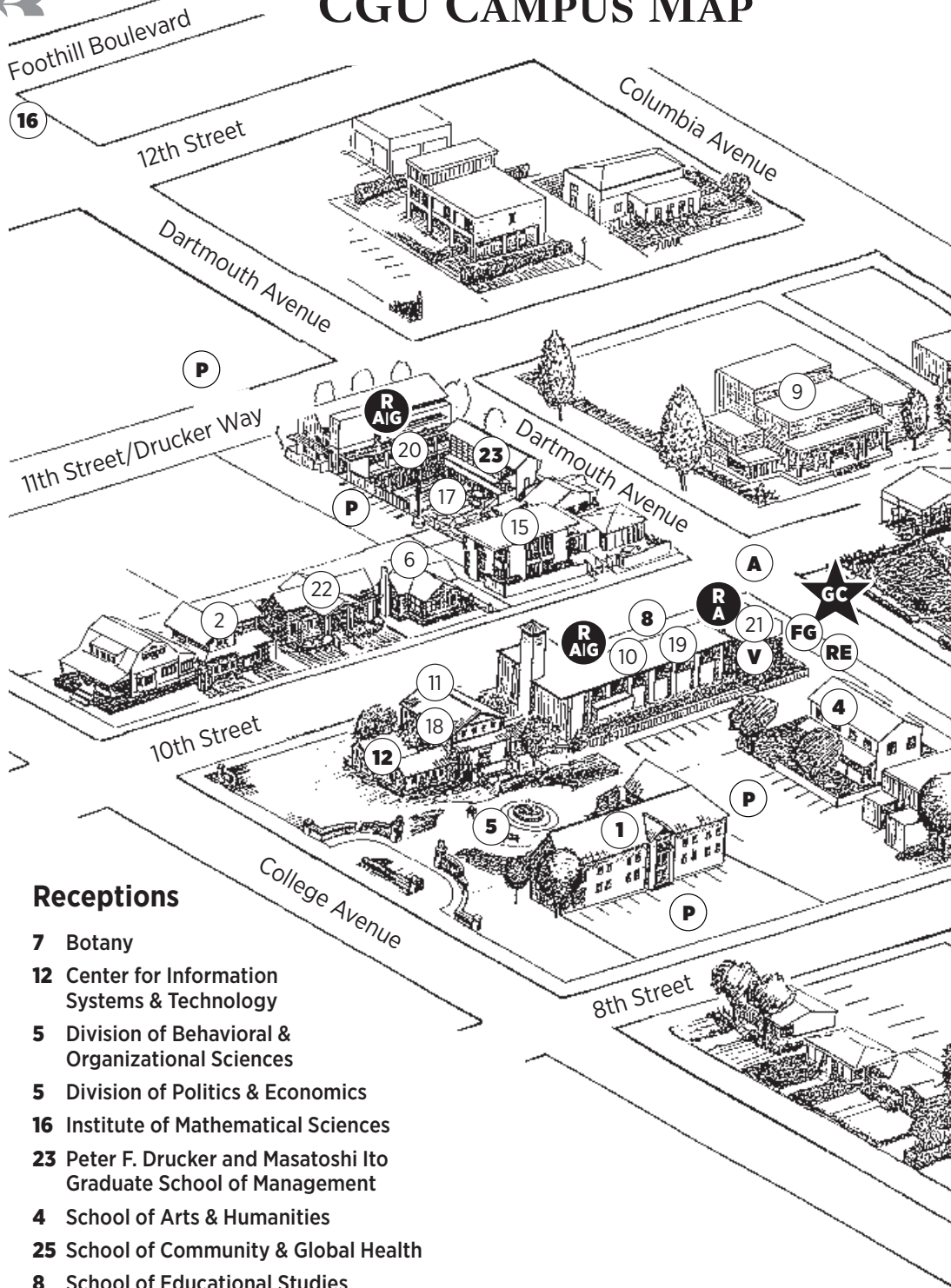

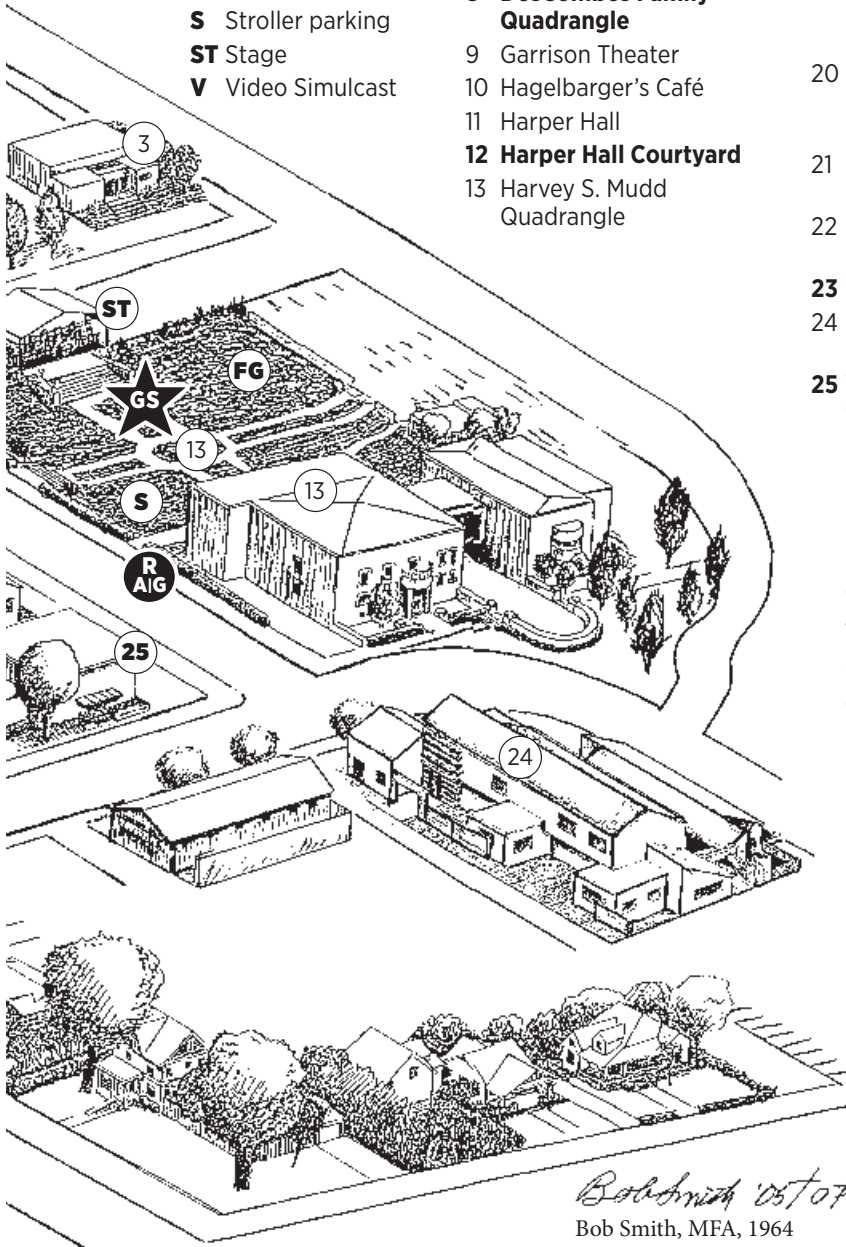
